1. κατάκριμα, ατος, τό punishment, doom Ro 5:16, 18; 8:1

- 2. ἐλευθερόω free, set free J 8:32, 36; Ro 6:18, 22; 8:2, 21; Gal 5:1
- 3. ἀδύνατος, ον powerless, weak of persons Ac 14:8; Ro 15:1. Impossible of things Ro 8:3; Hb 6:4, 18.
- 4. ἠσθένει διὰ τῆς σαρκός
- 5. God did the very thing that the Law, being powerless through the flesh, could not accomplish, by sending his Son in the similitude of sinful flesh, and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh. (Rom 8:3)
- 6. Those who live according to the flesh have their outlook shaped by the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit have their outlook shaped by the things of the Spirit. For the outlook of the flesh is death, but the outlook of the Spirit is life and peace, because the outlook of the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to the law of God, nor is it able to do so. Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. (Rom 8:5-8 NET)
- A. Paul proclaims a dualism two mindsets (Romans 11:38-12:2; Philippians 2:1-11)
- B. The two destinies: Death and Life with peace (not just life, but quality living)
- C. ἔχθρα, ας, ἡ enmity Lk 23:12; Ro 8:7; Gal 5:20; Eph 2:14, 16. ἔ. τοῦ θεοῦ hostility toward God Js 4:4.*
- D. When reading verse 8:8 remember the gospel of the Bethlehem angels to shepherds
