And the peace of God, which surpasses all 'comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (Phi 4:7 NASB)

Then the peace of God, which is beyond our utmost understanding, will guard your hearts and thought, in Christ Jesus. (Phi 4:7 NEB)
