- 2. Christ is said is the unique image of God: Col. 1:15 He is the image of (εἰκὼν τοῦ θεοῦ) the invisible God, the first-born of all creation; (πρωτότοκος πάσης κτίσεως,)
  - **a.** κτίσις, εως,  $\dot{\eta}$  **1.** creation **a.** the act of creation Ro 1:20.
  - **b.** ποωτότοκος, ον firstborn—1. Mt 1:25 v.l.; Lk 2:7; Hb 11:28.—2. fig. of Christ Ro 8:29; Col 1:15, 18; Hb 1:6; Rv 1:5; 2:8 v.1
- 3. Jesus unique role is as the one God has exalted.
  - a. μονογενής, ές only Lk 7:12; 8:42; 9:38; Hb 11:17. Only, unique J 1:14, 18; 3:16, 18; 1 J 4:9.
  - b. Jesus death is the "fulfillment of the Law" Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law, that all may believe into righteousness.
  - c. Romans 8:4 so that the just requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
  - d. Meaning:
    - i. Jesus was crucified and resurrected
    - ii. Jesus continues to live
    - iii. God has irrevocably identified as "god with us and for us" in Jesus
