- I. Review of our foundations:
 - a. God can only be know through (in) revelation
 - i. To the degree he predetermines
 - ii. God choses in absolute freedom
 - iii. God determines to be the God he is
 - b. God's will is God's purpose
- II. God acts his actions are first his Word
 - a. We know him by his acts recorded as scripture
 - b. God's Word is his own self gone forth
- III. God's being is consistent steadfast
 - a. Not as men think God changes and responds
 - b. God's consistency is in his being (Spirit) LOVE
- IV. Central to the act of God (God's predetermined will)
 - a. The Covenant Abraham (The slain lamb)
 - i. God's act in Jesus is Passover
 - ii. All revelation is in "His (THE) Hour"
 - b. The Covenant is God's given to man
 - i. It is not the Law It is not Israel
 - ii. It is the promise to Abraham
- V. God acts "in Christ"
 - a. The word "God" is not just "The Father"
 - b. Iesus is God who unites himself to man
