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Men in Christ

1 Corinthians 6:12 *All things are lawful for me, but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful for me, but I will not be enslaved by anything. Food is meant for the stomach and the stomach for food" – and God will destroy both one and the other. The body is not meant for immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body.*

Matthew 11:27 *All things have been delivered to me by my Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and any one to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.*

John 3:35 *The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand.*

1 Corinthians 8:5 *Although there may be so-called gods in heaven or on earth – as indeed there are many "gods" and many "lords" – yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and through whom we exist.*

1. Christian truth hears and bears witness to the Word of God - not just words about God. This come in an act of God.
2. The "Word" was made objective in Jesus of Nazareth - the Christ. It is subjective in us.
3. Jesus is the visible presentation of the invisible God - Word
4. The Word of God is never a predicate of man - except the One - He is Truth - He is Life - He is my God
5. The unseen God is revealed- unveiled - and yet veiled. In the human Jesus is revelation - we are to eat and drink him
6. God is revealed in his act - we know him actually - he is what the deeds of Jesus reveal - there is NO OTHER.
7. The subjective knowledge of God come in the event of his act - for us this is an encounter - revelation - epiphany.
