



Hebrews 1:5 For to what angel did God ever say, "Thou art my Son, today I have begotten thee"? Or again, "I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son"?

( Psalm 2:7 *I will tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to me, "You are my son, today I have begotten you.)*

Hebrews 3:7,13-15 *Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, "Today, when you hear his voice,*

*Psalm 95:7 For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness,*

*Hebrews 4:7 again he sets a certain day, "Today," saying through David so long afterward, in the words already quoted, "Today, when you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts."*

Hebrews 5:5 *So also Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, "Thou art my Son, today I have begotten thee"*

## God - The Living God

1. The scriptures teach God's ONENESS -Unity - Constancy - Uniqueness -

*John 17:11 And now I am no more in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to thee. Holy Father, keep them in thy name, which thou hast given me, that they may be one, even as we are one*

2. God is simple - (absence of division, absence of separation, absence of contradiction)
3. The absolute simplicity is self-determining - always faithful to his own self - True
4. God is always present (past - present - and future)

*Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.*

5. God's Word is - constant - always active and present
6. God in his Triune being is without beginning or ending
