Paul's Insight into The Revelation of Jesus

For I did not receive it from man, nor was I taught it, but it came through a revelation of Jesus Christ. (Gal 1:12 RSV)

But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and who called me by his grace, was pleased to reveal his Son to me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with anyone; (Gal 1:15 ESV)

Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to visit Cephas and remained with him fifteen days. But I did not see any other of the apostles except James, the Lord's brother. (Gal 1:19 NAU)

Then after fourteen years I went up to Jerusalem again with Barnabas, taking Titus along too. I went there because of a revelation and presented to them the gospel that I preach among the Gentiles. But I did so only in a private meeting with the influential people, to make sure that I was not running—or had not run—in vain. (Gal 2:1 NET)
