

## Friday Men in Christ – with – Gary Allen Henecke DD

*Inasmuch as many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the things which have been accomplished among us, just as they were delivered to us by those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word, it seemed good to me also, having followed all things closely for some time past, to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, that you may know the truth concerning the things of which you have been informed. (Luk 1:11-4 RSV)*

*I wrote the former account, Theophilus, about all that Jesus began to do and teach until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commandment through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. To the same apostles also, after his suffering, he presented himself alive with many convincing proofs. He was seen by them over a forty-day period and spoke about matters concerning the kingdom of God. While he was with them, he declared, "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait there for what my Father promised, which he said, you heard of from me . . . (Act 1:1-4)*

1. In all his acts God is himself - all that is God is him - Jesus is not "a" Lord - but "the" Lord.
2. The "Gospel" begins in God. We are to be careful. - to take care - to have care.
3. Beyond time - beyond the cosmos - beyond perception - the Logos - ὁ λόγος
4. This "Word" is God - this logic - reason - decision is "The Revelation"
5. God is . . . Revelation, Revealer, Relator (renewer)
6. This "Will" or "Word" is the life that lives - and gives life - this is reality - TRUTH.
7. By his "will" he creates and then recreates - all was the original "ὁ λόγος"
8. God chooses - God wills - God elects for himself to be in his creation as Lord.
