John 1:2 That life was made visible and we witnessed it. So, we are giving our testimony to you, declaring that Ageless Life which was present to the Father and has now been disclosed to us.

1 John 1:3 We are declaring to you what we witnessed through hearing and seeing, so that you may share in our common life, the life we share with the Father and his Son Jesus Christ.

I John 1:4 We are writing this so that your joy may be complete.
